Stage 2 Walking Excursion

Wednesday 9 November

Stage 2 is currently studying 'The effects of growth and change' for the COGS unit this term. All students in classes 3S, 3/4W and 4E be participating in a walking excursion with their class teachers on Wednesday 9 November (week 5). Students will be leaving the school at 11:40am and returning to school by 2:00pm.

Part of this unit includes studying how Tumut has changed over time and during our walk we will be looking at how various local landmarks have changed over the years.

We will be having lunch at Billa Park near the old town bridge. (We will probably be eating about 1:00pm) Parents are welcome to join us, however please notify your class teacher if you wish to do so. Don't forget to pack your child's lunch and a water bottle. They are to wear school uniform and must be wearing a hat. There will be no lunch orders available to these students on the day. They can bring a light towel to sit on if preferred.

Awards Day & Year 6 Farewell

The Tumut Public School Annual Awards Day will be held at the RSL Club on Wednesday 14 December. Students are to wear full school uniform with their blue polo shirt (No Yr 6 t-shirts). The Year 6 Farewell will be held at the same venue that night beginning at 6:30pm and students will wear full school uniform with their red Year 6 polo shirt. School Photos

School photos will be held on tomorrow -Tuesday 1 November.

Envelopes will be sent home as soon as they arrive from the photographers. Please note that ALL envelopes need to be brought back to school for photo day, regardless of whether you are ordering photos or not. If you wish to order, **correct payment** must be included in the envelope (the school cannot provide change).

If you would like to have a family photo taken (i.e. all siblings at school together as a group portrait) please collect the appropriate envelope from the school office.

Students are asked to wear full summer uniform on the day, this includes **black school shoes**. Ribbons and hair bands should be school colours. Year 6 students are also to bring their RED polo shirt for the Year 6 photo only.
