## **Principal's Prose**

#### **Attendance & Medication**

#### **Parents and Citizens Association**

The last long lunch provided the funding to renovate the weather shed to create our Alfresco Kitchen, at a cost of over \$23000, which has benefitted all the school students.

#### **Assessment Folders**

This year we are trialling a new aspect to our assessment and reporting process by sending home assessment folders each term containing the assessment tasks your child has completed at school. In the folders are working documents that the students will continue to use throughout the year. They are not glossy finished pieces of work that the student's are presenting as a final task. These folders will go home to be read by students and families and then returned to school the first day of the next term ready to be used again.

Our aim is to continue to build our school assessment and reporting processes and to support families with understanding where their child is achieving and where they may need some additional support. These folders will assist by providing samples of assessments and how the students have achieved in them. This is to be addressed, in addition to, school reports and 3-way interviews.

Work samples come home as part of our homework program and now we are building transparency into our assessment processes. It will still require some adjustments and we value your feedback.


